Theodore Anderson Seminary Scholarship Fund
Disbursement and Eligibility Policy

- 1) The Theodore Anderson Seminary Scholarship Fund (TASSF) exists to financially support members of Shepherd of the Lake Lutheran Church who are students at a seminary affiliated with the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America and intend to become Lutheran pastors.
- 2) Students are considered eligible each year after communication has occurred between a seminary and Shepherd of the Lake verifying the students’ enrollment and acceptable academic standing. It is desirable to have been granted candidacy status by the ELCA.
- 3) Funds will be disbursed to the seminary yearly at the beginning of the academic year.
- 4) The Foundation Board of Directors will determine the scholarship amount based on the following:
 - a. Number of students eligible for scholarships.
 - b. Membership of Shepherd of the Lake Lutheran Church for at least one year.
 - c. Account balance.
 - d. Scholarships are intended primarily for full-time students. Part-time students may be eligible, at the Board’s discretion, for a proportionate amount based on the number of credits taken as a proportion of the average full-time amount of credits, as determined by the seminary.
 - e. Students beginning classes during the academic year (e.g. second semester) will be eligible for scholarships at the beginning of the following academic year.
- 5) The Board of Directors of the Shepherd of the Lake Foundation reserves the right to modify this disbursement and eligibility policy at any time.
